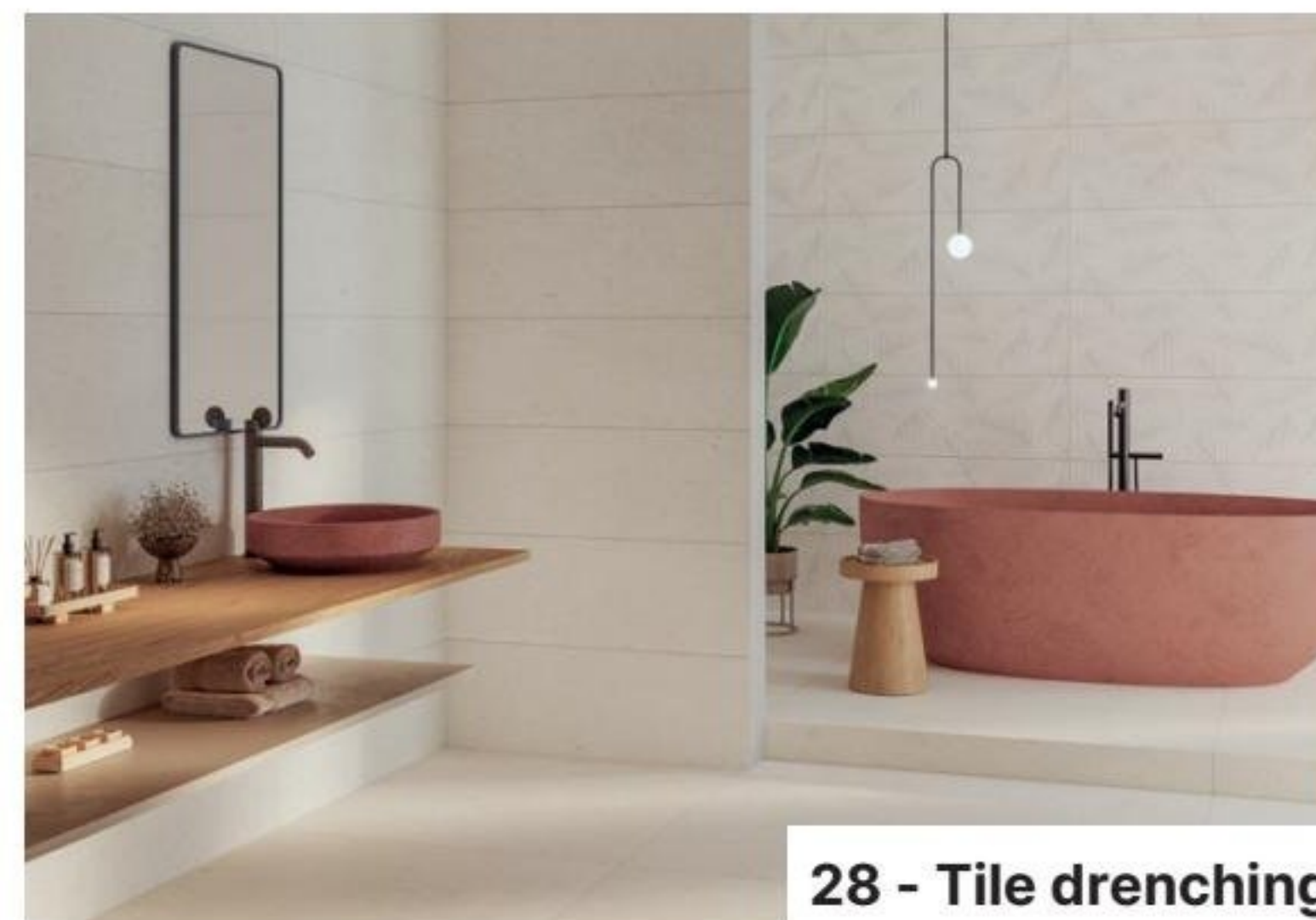

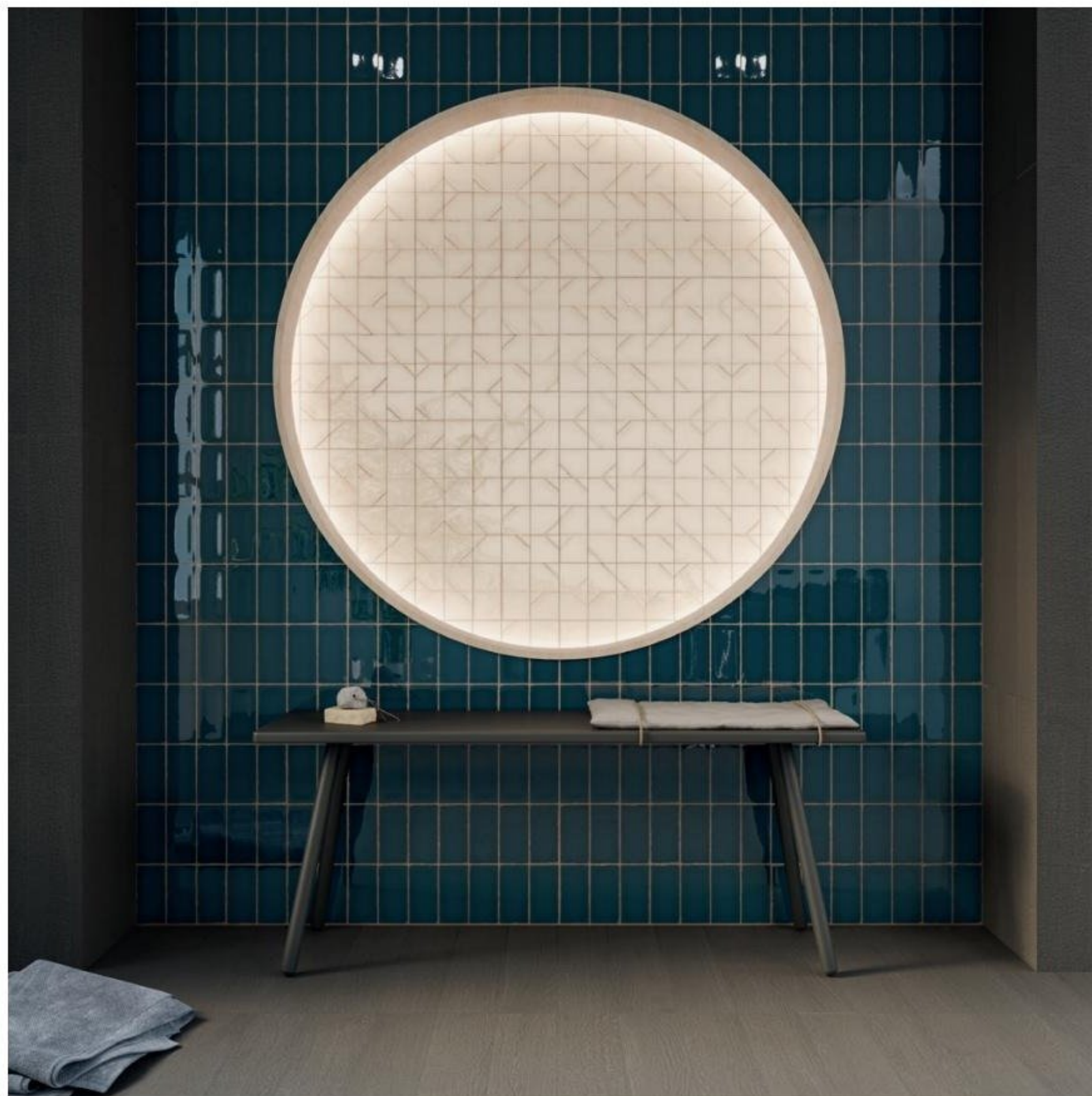

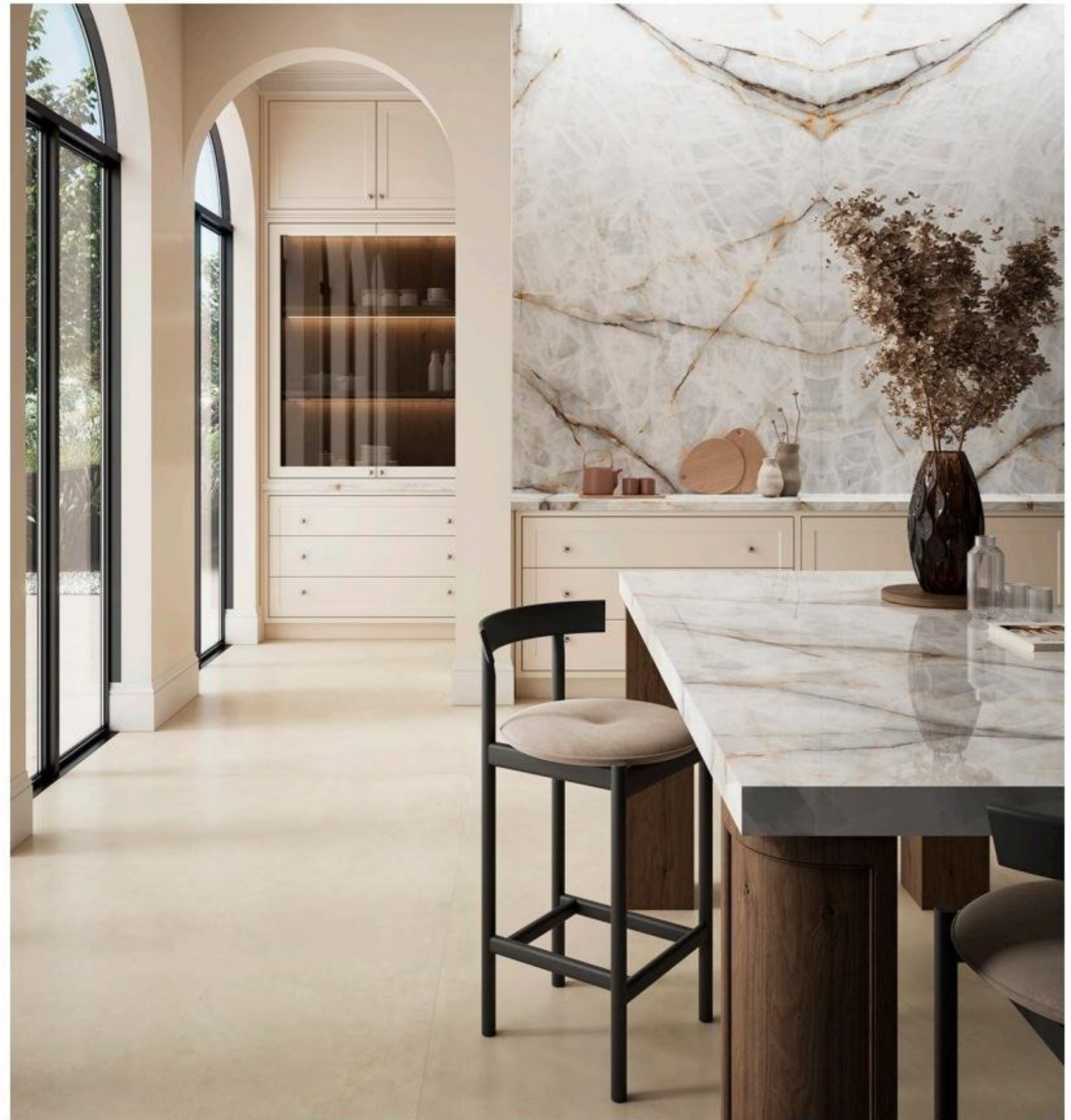
A touch of gold

The interplay of black and white remains a design classic, and this isn't slowing down in 2026.

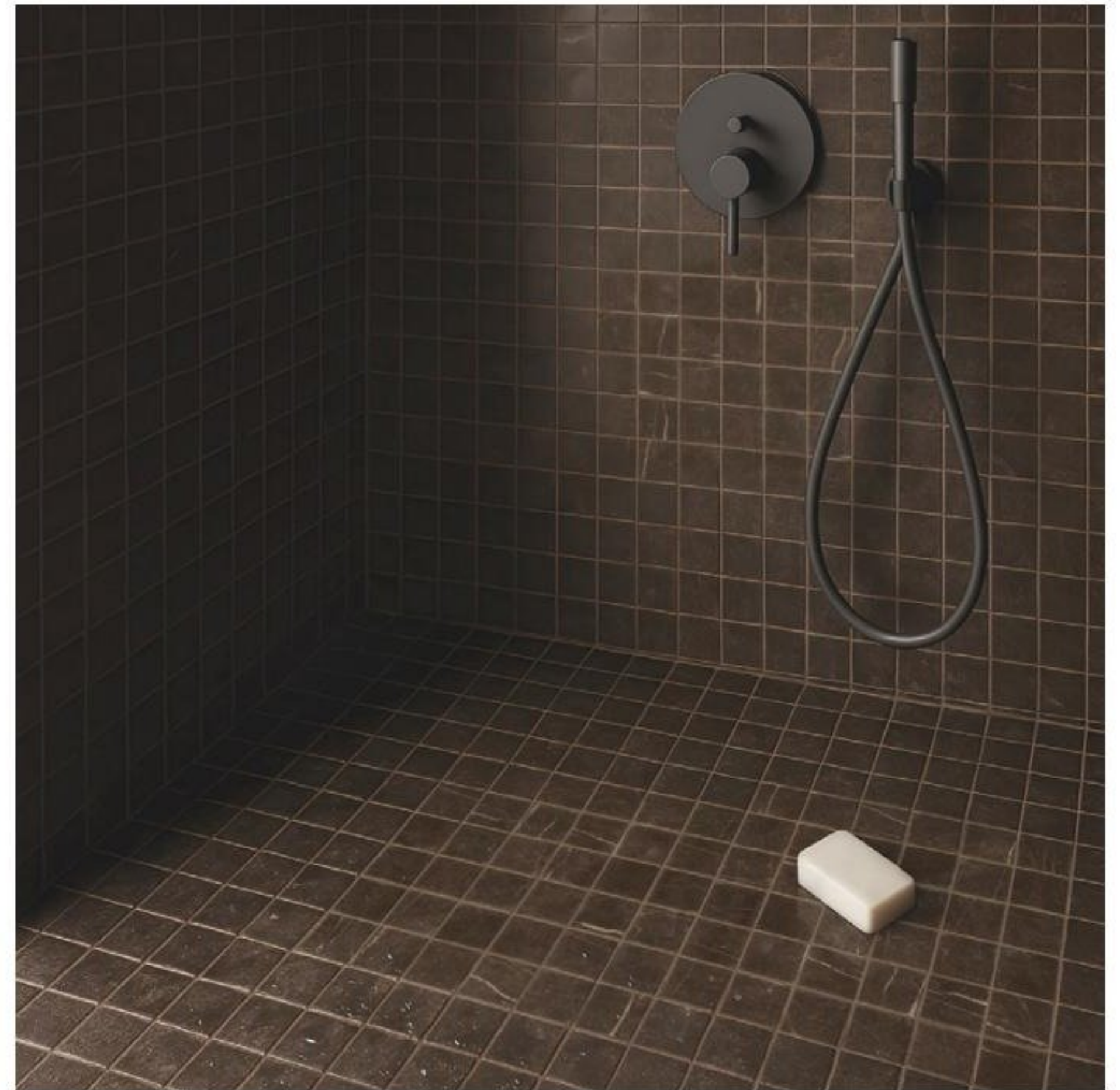

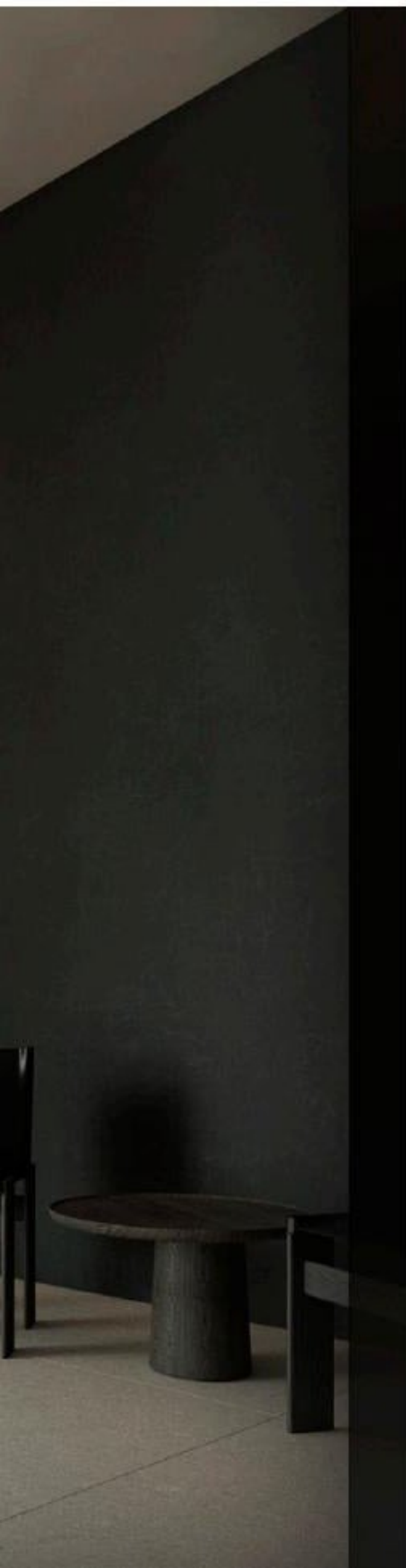

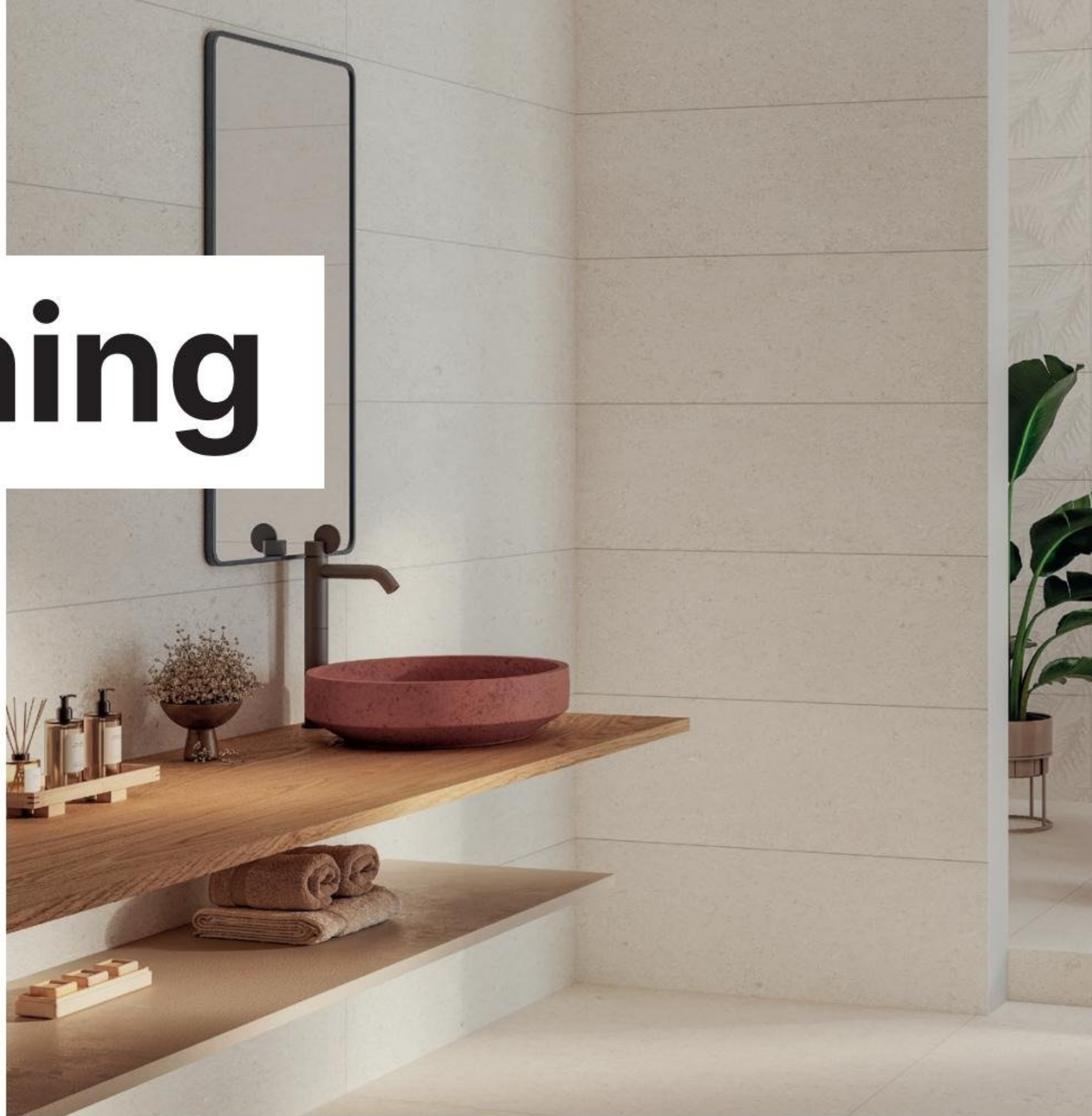
