distinctive reliefs

Innovations in 3D digital printing have elevated surface design to a new level, enabling the creation of hyper-realistic reliefs that are both tactile and visually striking. Unlike traditional techniques, which required moulds or embossing tools, today's digital relief printing allows texture to be applied with remarkable precision, even after the tile body is formed. This means textures can now align perfectly with graphic elements, such as deep veins in a marble-effect tile. Additionally, layered digital printing techniques introduce subtle, random variations in both tone and texture, giving each tile a unique identity. This evolution opens up a rich palette of design possibilities, where surface depth and pattern work in harmony.

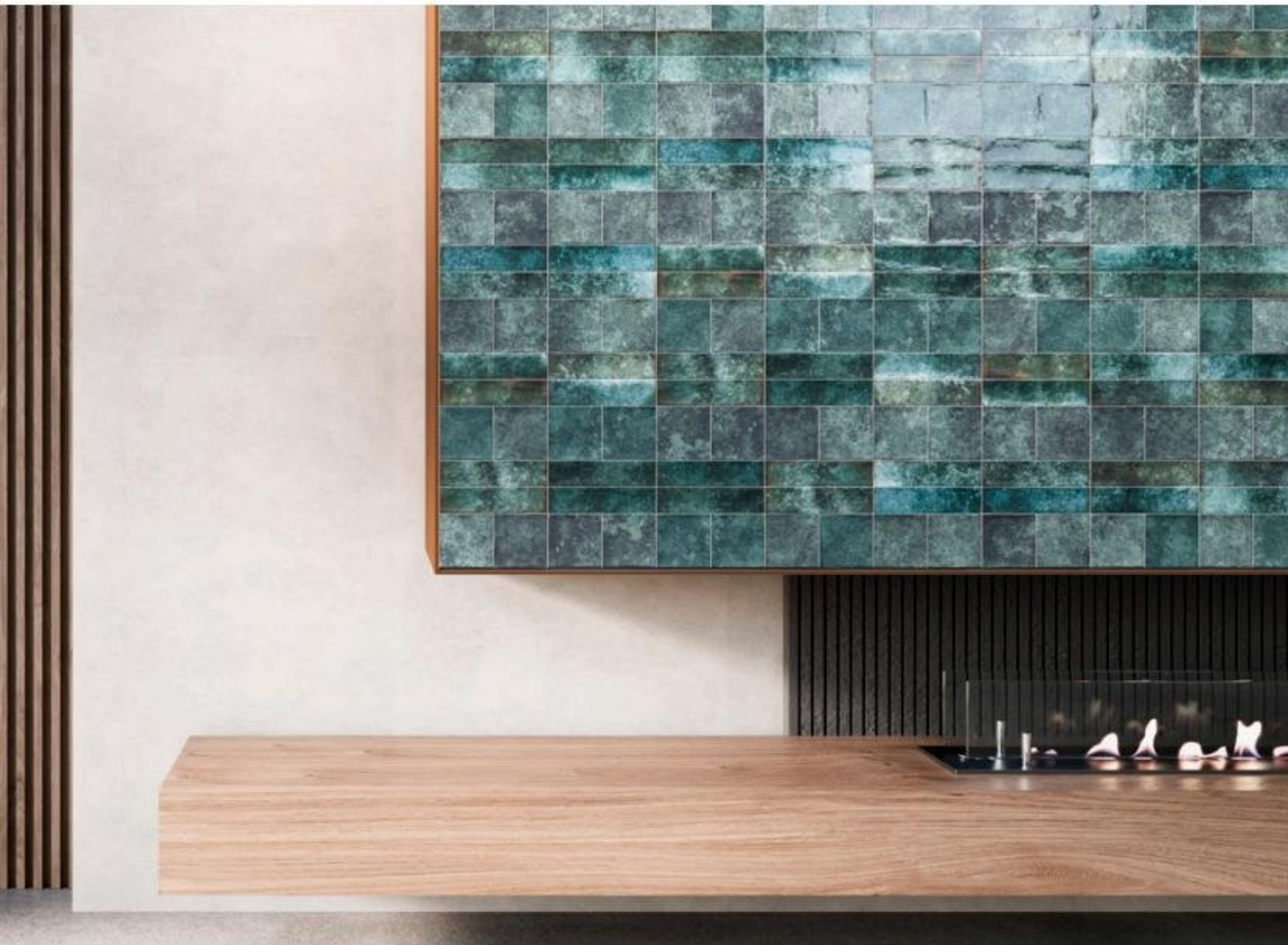

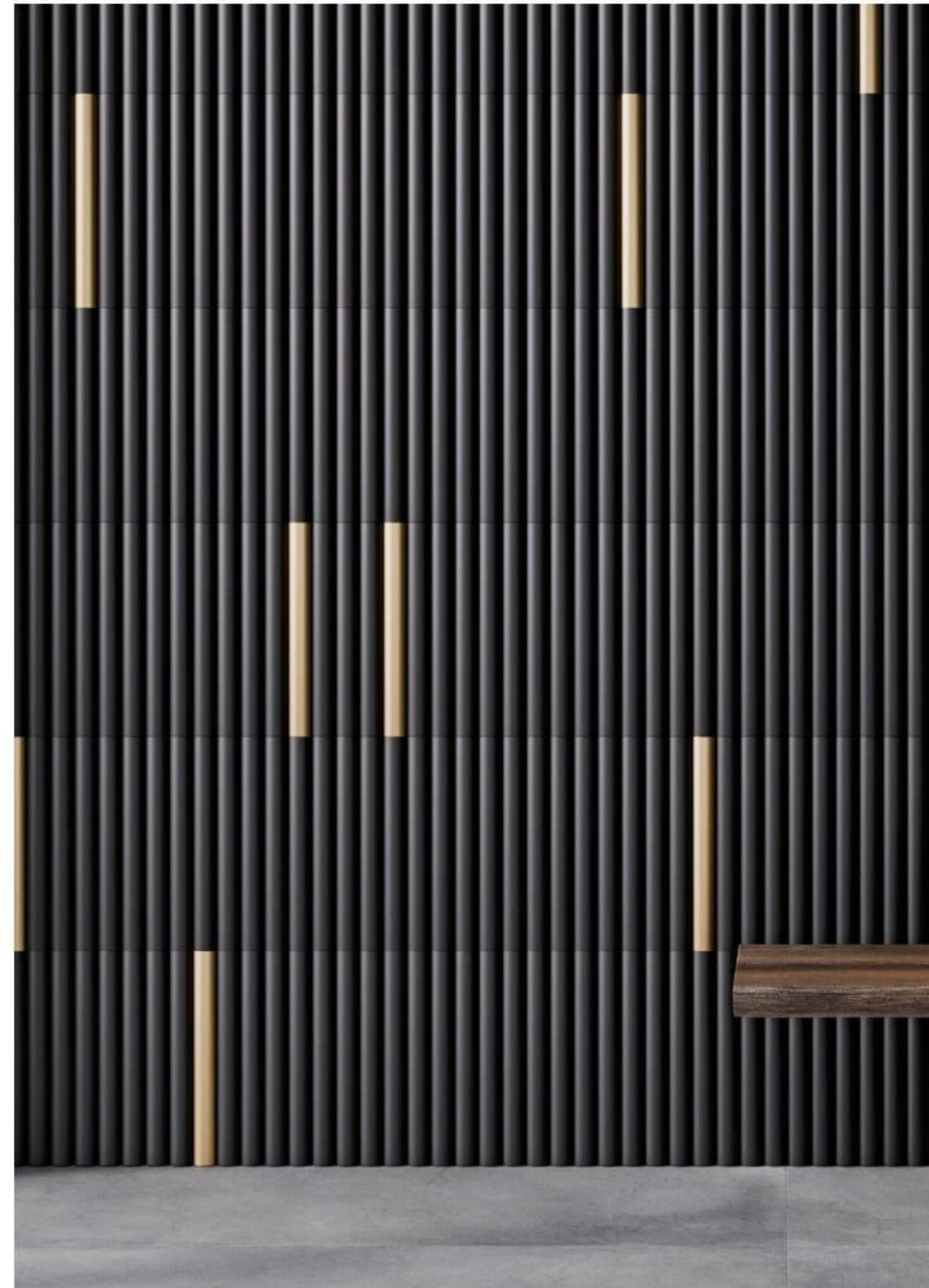

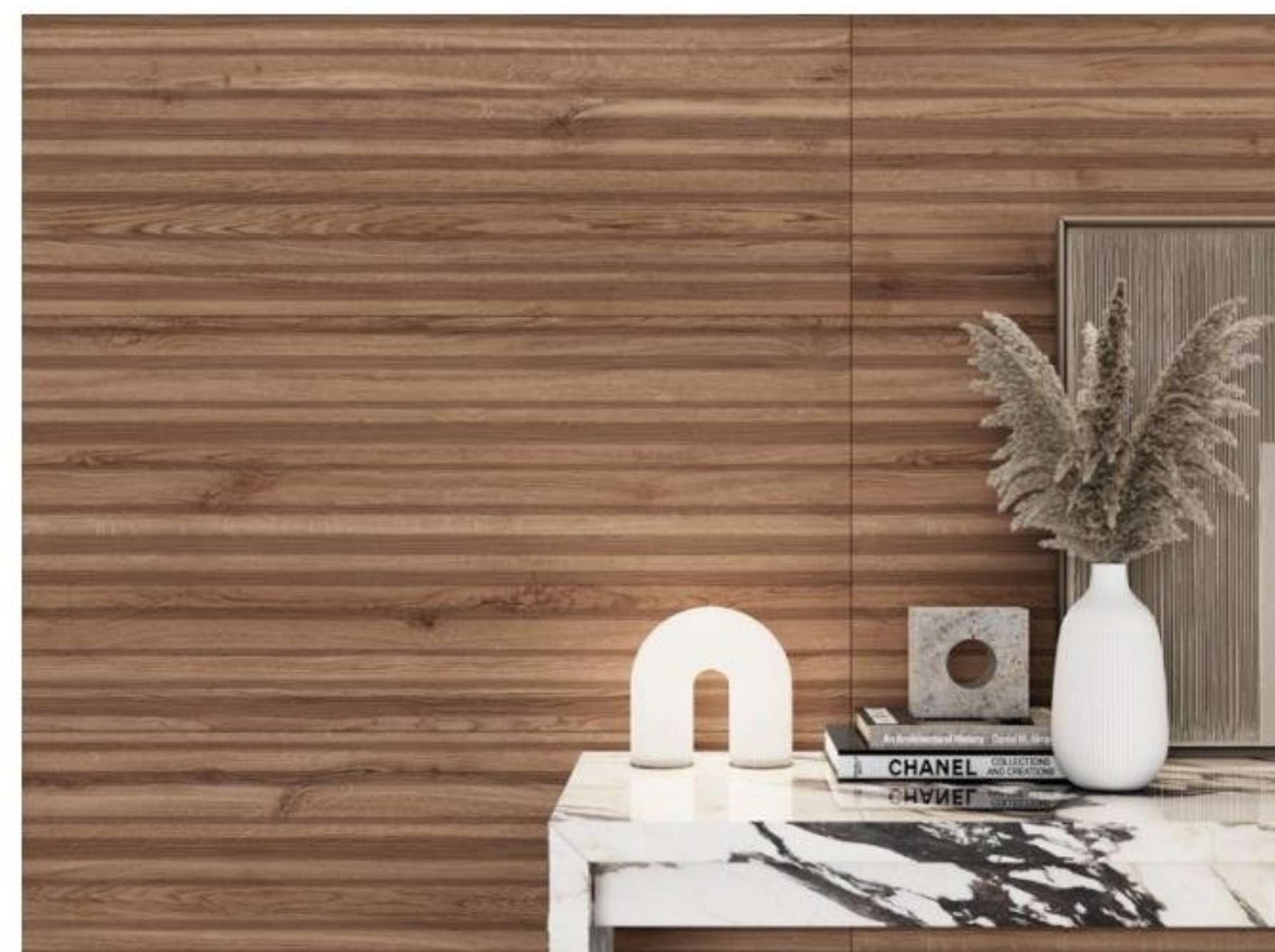

OVERSIZED SLABS

The trend towards large-format slabs has gained momentum, enabled by major advancements in manufacturing technology. These expansive surfaces, often with a slim profile, reduce grout lines, maximise visual impact and streamline installation. They also present sustainability advantages, with thinner slabs requiring fewer raw materials, shorter firing cycles and more efficient transport. However, producing these formats requires significant investment in equipment, from reinforced presses to specialised kilns. The result is a seamless look that transforms walls, floors and even furniture surfaces.
